## Judge Reyes Bordeaux's Procedures on Orders and Appearances

- 1. All orders that can be electronically lodged must be lodged via the Court's electronic Lodged Order Upload ("LOU") system. The prevailing party should lodge a proposed order (unless otherwise instructed by the Court) after the hearing.
- 2. Appearances are required unless Judge Reyes Bordeaux's Tentative Ruling for your matter states no appearance is necessary or that appearances have been waived. A moving party's failure to appear at the hearing will result in denial of the motion for failure to prosecute and may result in an issuance of an order to show cause re sanctions.
- 3. An opposing party who fails to appear on a motion that it opposed will be deemed to have withdrawn its opposition to the relief requested in the motion.
